

# **IRB COMPETITION TEAM**

## **Job Descriptions**

**Team Mechanic:** The Mechanic is responsible for the maintenance and scrutineering of the team equipment. It is their job to ensure all gear passes scrutineering at all carnivals. They must liaise with both the Team Captain and IRB Captain in regards to suggested equipment purchase and repairs relating to competition and training use. The Team Mechanic must satisfy the Club's IRB Captain that they have sufficient mechanical knowledge to manage the position.

**Team Coach:** The Team Coach is to put together a training program including both content and dates. They must ensure all team members are competent drivers/crewmen/passengers to the minimum standard set for IRB Competition. The Coach must be an accredited IRB coach as required by SLSA. The Coach should suggest and then work closely with the Team Captain regarding team combinations prior to race nominations being submitted. The Coach must be available to attend all training sessions and to organise an alternative IRB Coach to attend if necessary as per SLSA regulations.

**Team Manager:** Team Manager is to book and arrange transport for all IRB carnivals. They are also to enter or arrange to be entered into Carnival-mate, team nominations, prior to carnival cut off dates. The Team Manager is to attend all team meetings and to make themselves available for all carnivals. They must fulfil the Team Manager duties as required during race day and attend Team Manager meetings etc. The Team Manager has final say when at a competition, both on and off the beach. They are also required to work closely with the Team Captain

**Team Captain:** The Team Captain is to give the final approval to all requests from IRB Team members and is to liaise with and report to the Surf Sports Officer. The Team Captain is to work closely with the Coach and Team Manager ensuring the IRB Team maintains a culture of safety, competitiveness, team cohesion, skill development, inclusiveness and an overall positive image within the Surf Club and the wider community. The Team Captain will liaise with the Club Captain and IRB Captain to assist with training and up skilling of current Patrol IRB Drivers and Crewmen as required. The Team Captain signs off on all team submissions and is the final team authority should disputes arise.

All team positions are to be elected at an annual Team meeting to be held under the direction of the Surf Sports Officer.
